### Pumpkin Decorating Contest

Decerate a "literary" pumpkin & win! October 2025 | Ages 11-17 | Free Entry

The W.H. Walters Free Public Library is hosting its first ever LITERARY pumpkin decorating contest!

#### THE PULES:

1. Pumpkins must represent a book or book character.

2. The main component of your entry must be a pumpkin or something from the pumpkin family (such as squash or gourds). You must supply your own pumpkin.

3. You may paint, draw, decorate, or etch your pumpkin - but NO carving! Carved pumpkins rot, attract bugs, and smell. Carved

pumpkins will NOT be accepted.

4. You are free to use any materials to decorate your pumpkin, but no electrical power can be supplied, and candles are not allowed unless they are battery-operated.

All entries must be submitted by 5pm on Friday, October 24th, 2025.

Late entries will not be accepted.

6. This contest is open to tweens/teens ages 11-17.

7. Judging will take place on Thursday, October 30th, 2025, and the winners will be announced on Friday, October 31st.

8. Entries will be judged based on originality, creativity, quality, and

how well they reflect the chosen book.

9. Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place!
